Tax ID Number Documentation

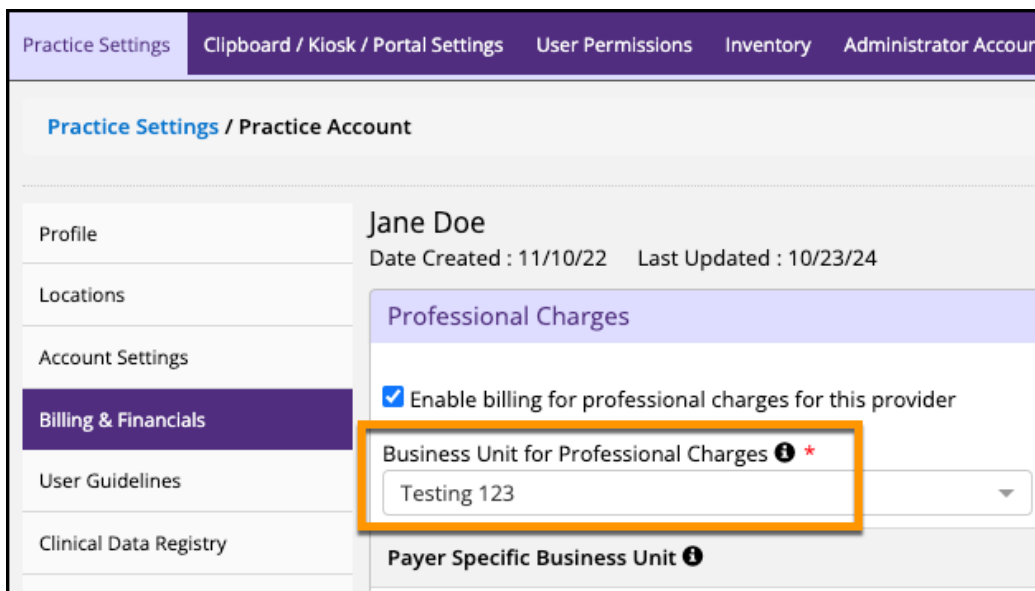
ModMed will include the **Tax ID Number (TIN)** with each visit sent to the 3rd party registry based on the documentation of the TIN in EMA.

Note: The TIN is a required field for data to populate in the registry correctly

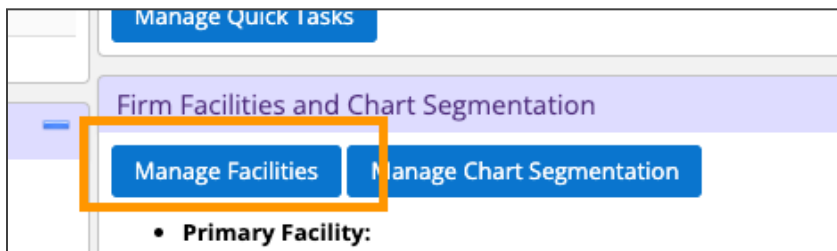

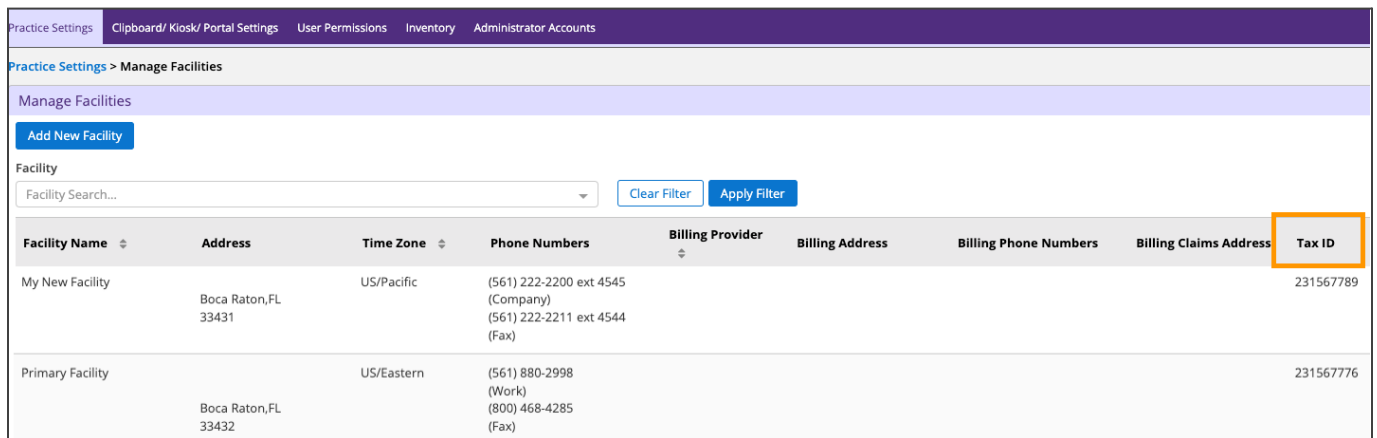

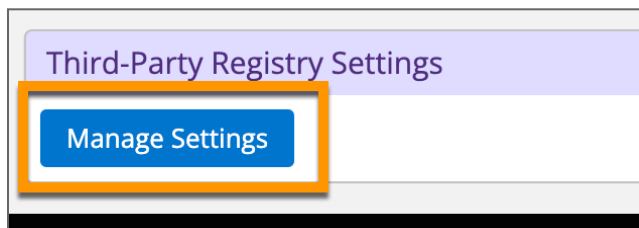
Before data can be sent from EMA, you must set up an account with your registry and obtain your unique registry ID

Setting up the Data Integration in EMA

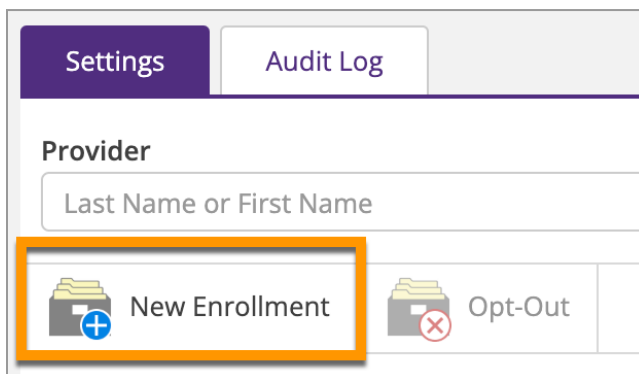
In order for EMA to send Quality data to your academy, the Account ID must be added to the firmadmin area of EMA.

Registry Admin Experience

- Log in to EMA's **firmadmin**
- Select **Manage Settings** under Third-Party Registry Settings



- Select **New Enrollment**



- Select the **Reporting Year**, **Registry Name**, and **Provider(s)**
- Choose the provider(s) who will be reporting to the registry and select **Opt-In**
- If you agree, select both checkboxes allowing ModMed to send data to your academy
- Select **Enter Details**
- Enter the Registry ID provided by your specialty academy
 - **Note:** The Account ID may be the same for each provider
- Select **Save**

Sending EMA Data to your Academy Registry

Once you've completed the Registry Admin Experience in firmadmin, ModMed will send your data to your academy registry monthly.

Your registry will grab the data and populate the measures in their Dashboard.
